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Classroom Discussion Questions

1. This video starts with a student standing in the rain who is crying and ends with friends together under a rainbow.

- What does this imagery mean to you?
- Do the illustrations depict how your emotions change when you have friends or people who care about you? Why or why not?

2. This video includes the line:

“I don’t bully.”

- What does this line mean to you?
- Do you think that kids who are bullied sometimes react by being unkind to other kids? Why or why not?

3. This video includes the line:

“I am different.”

- What does this line mean to you?
- Do you think kids are bullied for their differences? Why or why not?
- Do you think everyone is “different” in some way? Why or why not?

4. This video includes the line:

“Don’t make fun of me.”

- How do you think it feels to be made fun of for something you cannot change?
- What are ways to talk about differences, such as height and weight, disability, or academic skills, that will increase “acceptance” in your school?
- What are some activities to help students understand differences?
